To determine your eligibility for services, ALPI will need the following documentation:

- Photo identification
- Identification for all members of your household
- Proof of an energy obligation
- Income documentation for all members of the household aged 18 or above
- Proof of home ownership or rental agreement, including Section 8 Housing Lease
- Award letter for public assistance
- Documented Social Security numbers for all members of the household.
