APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- Randy Brock reported that BLFS has 192 current active members and 21 inactive.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- Ashley Vogel, Chair of the Educational Committee, offered flyers for the presentation, "Shedding Light on Senior Myths." Members can schedule a presentation and use the flyers for announcing the event.
- Advertising in the Directory: Liz Craven announced that there is going to be a new method for advertising in premier positions (back cover, inside covers, center) as more than one member has expressed interest in these positions. She explained that the board made a decision on how to fairly choose the premier advertising positions by holding a drawing at a monthly meeting. An e-mail will be sent out announcing the positions and the costs; those who are interested can submit their names by the next meeting. A drawing will be done at the next meeting for each advertising position and a backup will also be selected. Liz Craven echoed the importance of signing up for advertising when the e-mail arrives as there are limited positions for premium advertising.
